



Maeser Prep Activities Eligibility Policy

Approved - 10/09/18

All students at Maeser are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities as these activities provide opportunities for students to grow and learn. Extracurricular activities include but are not necessarily limited to: baseball, Broadway Rocks, basketball, cross country, debate, drama, golf, orchestra (solo & ensemble competitions), Shakespeare, soccer, Student Council, swimming, tennis, track & field, volleyball, and Ultimate Frisbee. Since academic performance is a *high priority* at Maeser, students must satisfy the following criteria in order to be eligible to participate in *any* extracurricular activity:

1. Students must earn a minimum 2.7 GPA with no Fs/NGs from the previous term in which the activity is occurring. The deadline for making up Fs/NGs will be the last day of the term.
2. Students must maintain a 2.7 GPA with no Fs/NGs during the term in which the activity is occurring.
3. High school students who have any Fs/NGs from any previous high school courses will be required to make-up the F and/or NG in order to be eligible.
4. Students must be enrolled at Maeser “full time.” This means students must be enrolled in at least 6 classes.
5. Students must have all necessary forms filled out, signed, and on file with the office and have all fees paid.
