ANNUAL STUDENT FEES

- Annual student fees, Winterim fee and graduation fee are eligible for payment plans.
 - To request a payment plan, please stop by or email the Finance Office at finance@maeserprep.org *before* fee due dates.
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- **Annual student fees:** HS: Student admission to home sports events \$20, assemblies/mentoring \$10, locker rental \$10, instructional materials \$30, student planners \$10, textbooks \$30, technology \$50. MS: Middle school Intensives Field Trips \$25, locker rental \$10, PE Uniform \$26, instructional materials \$24, student planners \$10, textbooks \$30, technology \$25.
 - **Winterim:** Winterims vary by offering and cost; however by the end of a student's high school experience they will receive the value of their contributions in winterim trips, experiences, and supplies.
Independent: \$10 printing and winterfest booth. Winterim: Transportation (buses, charter buses, rental vehicles, fuel) \$50, Lodging/Food \$100, Tours/Field Trips/Supplies \$50.
If your student withdraws by the end of Quarter 1, this fee is refundable.
 - **Graduation:** Fee covers venue (\$50); diploma covers, cords, transcripts, printing, and awards (\$15), and senior breakfast (\$10). If your student withdraws by the end of first semester, this fee is refundable.
 - **Uniforms:** Families purchase uniforms, according to the dress code, from approved vendors (Lands' End, Dennis Uniform & Timpanogos Embroidery) and/or used uniform sales. Check with vendors for pricing. A limited number of used uniforms are also available for purchase in the front office at discounted prices. Fee waiver families are provided uniforms.

CLASS FEES

- Most class fees are eligible for payment plans.
 - AP exam fees and PE uniforms are *not* eligible for payment plans.
 - AP exam fees must be paid in full by Thursday, October 1, 2020, or your student will be removed from his/her AP class.
 - To request a payment plan, please stop by or email the Finance Office at finance@maeserprep.org *before* fee due dates.
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- **Concert Choir/ Chorale:** Fee covers shirt (\$15), binder (\$15), and sheet music (\$5)
 - **Film As Art:** Workbook/manual \$20
 - **Orchestra:** Fee covers sheet music
 - **Photography:** Mounted 20x30 poster \$55, Supplies/SD cards \$10
 - **Science Labs:** Lab fees include dissections, protective equipment, pipettes, trays, cultures, etc.
 - **Show Choir:** Transportation/Registration Fees \$50, Jacket \$30, Sheet Music/Props \$20
 - **Theatre Tech:** Field Trips/Plays \$10, Show Shirt \$5, Gloves, Protective Equipment, Tools \$10
 - **Video Production:** Gallery Field Trip \$10, Equipment/Supplies \$5
 - **Zumba:** Zumba Instructor/Zumba Licensing \$10
 - **AP Class Exam:** AP Exams \$100 All AP students are required to pay for and take the AP class exam. This fee covers exams, proctors, and facility rental.
 - **AP Class Books/Materials:** AP Study Guides \$25-\$70 Students purchase and keep these materials.
 - **Concurrent Enrollment Books/Materials:** Books and materials required by the particular CE course. Students purchase and keep these materials.
 - **Foreign Language Books/Materials:** Workbooks such as "Asi se Dice" and Latin workbooks. Students purchase and keep these materials.
 - **PE Uniform:** 7th grade students receive their first PE uniform as part of their student fee (one set of shirt & shorts). Additional PE uniforms are purchased in the front office.
 - **Orchestra:** Maeser Prep has a few instruments to lend students. You most likely will need to provide your own instrument. Typical rental prices from local suppliers are \$20-140/mo.
 - Some classes require students to complete class projects (unit projects, science projects, etc). Students are given several options, some of which require them to purchase materials and others that are no-cost.

EXTRACURRICULAR FEES

- Students are *not eligible* for extracurricular activities if they have outstanding fees.
 - Extracurricular fees must be paid in full before student participates.
 - Extracurricular fees are *not* eligible for payment plans. Payment deadlines will be posted.
 - Extracurricular fees are **non-refundable** after the payment deadline, even if the student subsequently chooses not to participate or loses eligibility according to the Maeser Activities Eligibility Policy.
 - Students/families may be asked to provide their own snacks/meals (or to bring money to purchase such) for some extracurricular activities. In addition, sometimes parents will choose to coordinate with each other to provide snacks/meals to students during games, tournaments, etc.--this is not required by the school and participation is completely voluntary. Some extracurricular activity fees include meals.
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- **Baseball (HS):** Fee covers coach stipends (\$117), field rental (\$67), uniforms (\$54), umpires (\$47), bus driver (\$33), post-season tournament (\$17.50), gas (\$16.50), bats & balls (\$16.50), and helmets (\$6.50). Students are required to provide their own mitt, baseball practice pants and cleats.
 - **Baseball (MS):** Fee covers uniforms (\$75), umpires (\$36), and field rental (\$19). Students are required to provide their own mitt,

baseball practice pants and cleats.

- **Basketball (HS):** BOYS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$125), referees (\$66.50), bus driver (\$23.50), fuel (\$23.50), practice jerseys (\$20), and equipment (\$16.50). GIRLS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$133), referees (\$64), bus driver (\$25), fuel (\$25), equipment (\$18), and uniforms (\$10). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Basketball (MS):** Fee covers charter league fee (\$72), coach stipend (\$39), equipment/uniforms (\$15.50), bus driver (\$12.50), and fuel \$12. Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Cross Country (HS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$100), race fees (\$35), bus driver (\$24), fuel (\$24), food & water (\$12), senior awards (\$9), uniforms (\$15), and equipment (\$6). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Cross Country (MS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$26.50), charter league fees (\$33.50), bus driver (\$15), uniforms/equipment (\$16.50), and fuel (\$8.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Soccer (HS):** BOYS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$75), practice balls (\$50), net (\$20), referees (\$46.50), bus driver (\$21), fuel (\$20), equipment (\$10), socks (\$4), ball bags (\$3.50). GIRLS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$75), practice balls (\$50), net (\$20), referees (\$46.50), bus driver (\$21), fuel (\$20), equipment (\$10), socks (\$4), ball bags (\$3.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment and practice attire.
- **Soccer (MS):** Fee covers charter league fee (\$50.50), coach stipend (\$40), uniforms/equipment (\$30), bus driver (\$12), and gas (\$2.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment and practice attire.
- **Swimming (HS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$192), uniforms/suits (\$84), pool rental (\$80), shirts (\$28), meet fees (\$12), miscellaneous (\$4). Students provide their own goggles and extra practice gear if needed.
- **Swimming (MS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$172.50), uniforms (\$76), pool rental (\$72), shirts (\$25), meet fees (\$11), miscellaneous (\$3.50). Students provide their own goggles and extra practice gear if needed.
- **Tennis (HS):** BOYS: Fee covers coach stipend (\$78), facility rental (\$76.50), bus driver (\$17.50), uniforms (\$17.50), tennis balls (\$17.50), travel/fuel (\$12), equipment (\$6). GIRLS: Fee covers coach stipend (\$78), facility rental (\$76.50), bus driver (\$17.50), uniforms (\$17.50), tennis balls (\$17.50), travel/fuel (\$12), equipment (\$6). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Track & Field (HS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$133.50), event costs (\$26.50), bus driver (\$20), fuel (\$16.50), food & water (\$14.75), and equipment (\$13.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Ultimate Frisbee (HS/MS):** HS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$45); team registration (\$7.50), coach certifications, NCSI background check & coaching registration (\$7), jerseys (\$5.50), tournament fees (\$52.50), and equipment (\$5). HS students pay a \$75 individual USAU annual membership directly to USAU; coaches will provide instructions. MS: Fee covers coach stipends (\$45); team registration (\$7.50), coach certifications, NCSI background check & coaching registration (\$7), jerseys (\$5.50), tournament fees (\$5), and equipment (\$5). Students are required to provide their own footwear and practice attire.
- **Volleyball, Boys (HS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$83.50), league fee (\$28.50), bus driver (\$41.50), transportation (\$30), and equipment (\$16.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment and practice attire.
- **Volleyball, Girls (HS):** Fee covers coach stipends (\$130), referees (\$40), fuel (\$28), equipment (\$18), bus driver (\$16), uniforms (\$12), and miscellaneous (\$6). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment, practice attire and shorts (for uniform).
- **Volleyball, Boys (MS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$41.50), charter league fee (\$41.50), driver (\$17), uniforms/equipment (\$16.50), and fuel (\$8.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment and practice attire.
- **Volleyball, Girls (MS):** Fee covers coach stipend (\$41.50), charter league fee (\$41.50), driver (\$17), uniforms/equipment (\$16.50), and fuel (\$8.50). Students are required to provide their own footwear, safety equipment, practice attire and shorts (for uniform).
- **Wrestling (HS):** Fee covers coaching stipend (\$200), facility (\$100), tournament fees/tests/travel (\$50), supplies and uniforms (\$50). Students provide footwear and headgear.
- **Practice Squad (MS):** Transportation to games \$25
- **Sports Camp:** fee covers tournament fees, lodging, transportation, and food.
- **Sports Uniform Replacement:** Uniforms are often designed to last 5+ years, thus the \$100 replacement cost.
- **Broadway Rocks:** \$5 Cast Shirt, \$5 Sheet Music/Backing Tracks
- **Debate Team (HS/MS) + NSDA Membership & Tournaments:** Basic participation fee (\$150 HS / \$100 MS) covers coach stipends, transportation, debate briefs and tournament team entry fees. Participation in tournaments is optional but highly encouraged. Each high school debate student who participates in one or more tournaments will be charged a one-time fee of \$20 for NSDA membership. Tournament fees are \$4 for each of your student's entries (one to four per tournament) and \$2 per pizza meal (one provided each day of the tournament). Your student's account will be charged an initial \$100/\$40 (HS/MS) to cover fees for all local tournaments; any balance will be refunded and any deficit will be charged. If a student fails to participate in a tournament after the drop deadline, they will not receive a refund for the tournament fee and their account will be charged a \$25 cancellation fee. Region and state tournaments, if students qualify, may require further travel within the state -- costs for these tournaments will vary but will be based on actual expenses for entry fees, transportation, meals, and lodging.
- **Drama Productions (HS or All School):** Cast Shirts \$5, Costumes/Sets/Props \$20-35, Rights/Rentals \$20-\$25, Director Stipends \$5
- **Drama Productions (MS):** What does \$15-50 cover? Cast Shirts \$7, Costumes/Sets/Props \$4-30, Rights/Rentals \$4-15
- **Drama Tournaments:** Costs will vary but will be based on actual expenses for entry fees, transportation, meals, and lodging.
- **Math Team (HS/MS):** \$20 Competition Fees, \$25 Pizza/snacks during practices/competitions
- **Mock Trial:** Fee covers competition fee, transportation, etc. National tournament, if students qualify, will require travel outside the state -- cost for this tournament will be based on actual expenses for entry fees, transportation, meals, and lodging.
- **Model UN Team (required for AP Geog):** Model UN fees \$20, Lunch \$5
- **National Honor Society:** NHS Fees \$10, Pin/Honor Cords \$10, Induction/Activities \$10, Advisor Stipend \$10
- **National Latin Exam:** This fee covers the cost of the exam.
- **Science Olympiad Team:** \$10 Registration Fees, Food \$10, Supplies \$30
- **Shakespeare Competition (HS/MS):** MS - Transportation \$25, Shirt \$5, Lodging/Food \$120, Costumes/Props/Entry Fees/Supplies \$50, Stipends \$25. HS - Transportation \$25, Shirt \$5, Lodging/Food \$120, Costumes/Props/Entry Fees/Supplies \$50, Stipends \$25

- **Student Council (HS/MS):** HS - Pin \$10, Retreat Food/Lodging \$25, Advisor Stipends \$20. MS - Advisor Stipends \$20, Supplies \$5. HS Student Council fee is due in May of election year.
- **Symphony & Opera Concert Group:** \$20 fee covers all concert tickets. Students pay an additional \$30 for transportation (UTA FrontRunner & Trax) unless they already have a free UTA pass.
- **Optional Field/Overnight Trips:** Optional field trips and/or overnight trips may be offered throughout the year. Prices will vary and will be based on factors such as transportation, meals, housing, entry fees, etc.
- **Internship Intensive:** Fee covers teacher stipend and field trips.
- **Traveling College Tour:** Fee covers transportation, meals, housing, entry fees, etc.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES

- **Class Change:** Schedule printing and administrative time \$10
- **Parking Pass:** This fee covers parking pass printing and parking lot maintenance.
- **Parking Ticket:** This fee covers administrative costs to monitor parking passes and parking lot maintenance.
- **Lock Replacement:** This fee covers the cost of a new lock.
- **Textbook/Library Book Replacement:** This fee covers the cost of the replacement book (cheapest option in similar condition to lost copy) plus a \$3 administrative fee. If the student returns the book before a replacement is ordered, we will remove the fee from their account.
- **Copy/Print Card:** This fee covers toner for the printers & copy machines..
- **Attendance School:** Teacher time \$5
- **School Activities:** Chaperones, decorations, supplies \$3-\$10
- **School Dances:** DJ, decorations, chaperones, venue, supplies \$20-\$40
- **School Spirit Shirts, Stickers, Etc:** StuCo may provide spirit shirts, stickers, etc. that are available to purchase and are optional.
- **Yearbook:** Purchase directly from jostens.com.
- **Video Yearbook & End-of-Year Insert:** Purchase directly from jostens.com.
- **Credit Recovery / Credit Ahead:** Independent Study Enrollment \$60 per course
- **Summer School (On Campus):** Independent Study Enrollment \$60 Tutoring \$40
- **Math Placement Test (New Students):** Testing cost, teacher time
- **Diploma Replacement Fee:** This is the fee that Jostens charges to Maeser

LATE FEES

- Late fees pay for the extra time and resources spent to make alternate arrangements with parents/students/teachers, to send reminders and/or invoices, to recover fees, etc. when posted deadlines are not met.
