



Maeser Prep Uniform Policy



Purpose of the Uniform

Maeser believes that education is a serious and weighty endeavor. Thus, in many ways schools can be special buildings. They are a place where students can converse with the sages of the past, grapple with the issues of today, and wonder at the mysteries of tomorrow. Just as someone might dress differently or in a specific way for a job or activity, students dress in school uniforms to prepare their minds and bodies for the transformational act of learning. Wearing clothes that are different from a student's normal, everyday attire indicates that there is something special about what they are doing.



Middle School

Mondays: **Full Dress** red cardigan/vest, white button up shirt, Maeser navy blue tie/cross tie, khakis pants or skirt.

Tuesday-Friday: **Standard Dress** Polo (light blue or gold) and navy or khaki colored bottoms. **Any Maeser outerwear must be worn with a polo underneath it.**

Shoes - Closed toe with a back; crocs ok, but in *sport mode* only.

Skirt/shorts length - with arms extended down, must go past fingertips.

Red cardigan or V-Neck sweater with logo

White button down shirt

Khaki pant or khaki skirt/skort

Standard Dress



High School

Mondays: **Full Dress** Navy blazer, white button up shirt, Maeser red and blue tie or red cross tie, khakis pants or plaid skirt/skort.

Tuesday-Friday: **Standard Dress** Polo (red, white, or navy) and navy or khaki colored bottoms. **Any Maeser outerwear must be worn with a polo underneath it.**

Shoes - Closed toe with a back; crocs ok, but in *sport mode* only.

Skirt/shorts length - with arms extended down, must go past fingertips.



High School Full Dress



Navy Blazer with logo

White button up shirt

High school tie/cross tie

Khaki pant or plaid skirt/skort



All shirts must have the Maeser logo on them on standard dress days.

Hair Accessories/Hats

Wearing hats, hoods, scarves, tiaras, headbands with cat ears etc., in the buildings is not allowed. Functional headbands may be worn.



Approved Outerwear (Jackets, Hoodies, Sweatshirts)

- “Maeser” and “Lions” Zip-up hoodies and crew neck sweaters
- Activity outerwear (navy blue, activity logo)
- The “Maeser scarf” is approved



Unapproved Items

- Any jacket, hoodie, sweatshirt, or coat that's not explicitly approved
- Random scarves
- Blankets
- Beanies
