

4105 Student Parking

1. Parking permits
 - a. All students who drive and park on campus are required to have a student parking permit.
 - b. A parking permit application can be obtained in the front office or from the school website.
 - c. When applying for a parking permit, a valid driver's license, proof of insurance and parent/guardian signature are required. (*Please bring a copy of your license and proof of insurance to the front office. These will be kept on file and will be shredded at the end of the year.*)
 - d. Registered permits are assigned to the vehicle by number and will be tracked based on the license plate number.

Permits are non-transferable and non-refundable.
2. Display of parking permit
 - a. All students who park on campus must display a valid Maeser-issued parking permit in a highly visible location on their windshield or rear window.
3. Parking locations
 - a. Students with a valid permit are only allowed to park in the student lot located at the north end of the school.
 - b. Students are not allowed to park in the faculty lot on the south end of the school.
 - c. Students should not park in the seminary parking lot.
 - d. No parking is permitted in the circular driveways, faculty/visitor lots, bus area, fire lanes, or any restricted areas.
4. Driving on Maeser property
 - a. The speed limit in Maeser parking lots is 10 mph.
 - b. Students should follow all posted signs and directions given by parking lot attendants.
 - c. Students are expected to use good judgment behind the wheel.
5. Violations
 - a. Cars parked in the parking lot without the appropriate permits will be subject to citations and may be towed at the owner's expense.
 - b. Cars may not be left in the parking lot overnight.
 1. Cars that are left in the parking lot overnight may be towed at the owner's expense.
 - c. If more than three (3) citations are received, the vehicle may be booted or towed and/or the student's parking privileges may be revoked.
 - d. Parking citations will be charged to the offending student's account, in accordance with the published fee schedule.
 - e. Vehicles parked illegally are subject to towing at the owner's expense.
 - f. Reckless driving is strictly prohibited. Students who drive recklessly may have their parking permit revoked.
6. Liability
 - a. Maeser is NOT liable for vehicles or their contents.
 - b. All vehicles parked on campus are subject to search in accordance with state and local laws and policies.
